

Join new clean air group for campaign with Mittal Steel



Come to a community meeting with Ohio Citizen Action at Alexia Manor on Wednesday, February 7 at 7:00pm.

We will be forming a new neighbor-based clean air group to unite Clevelanders in working to get Mittal Steel to clean up their act.

Mittal Steel has been polluting Cleveland's air since they took over the Cleveland steel mill in April 2005. The company does no testing at its blast furnaces, the dirtiest part of their operation. Instead they have been using an outdated formula to come up with pollution estimates that they report to the EPA. This means that Mittal Steel has no idea how much pollution they are putting into our air each year.

Northeast Ohio neighbors have sent 24,500 personal letters and petitions asking Mittal Steel to fix the problems. Mittal's decision makers have not responded. It's time to form a united community effort that the company cannot ignore. Come to share your input and to get involved.
